By the time you receive this letter, we will be on our way with 24 high school students headed for a NYC Mission Trip! Samantha and I went last year during Spring Break, and this year Trish will be going with us.

We will be working with a church in White Plains, NY who last year was just beginning their services. The attendance is now up to about 40! For the area, this number is terrific! We will help them get the word out about their upcoming Easter services through a variety of ways, such as a canned food drive, door hangers and surveys that engage people in conversations about Christ. Please pray for our week there, that many hearts would be open to have 'Gospel seeds' planted and take root. It's exciting to see these students want to take leaps of faith ... pray they would be encouraged as they 'see' God work!

**BIG WEEKEND** --- Every year our church high school ministry puts on Big Weekend, (formerly Disciple Now). We hosted freshman guys this year and had a blast! The smell wasn't nearly as bad as the 8th graders we had last November...what happens in that span of one year? Just kidding ... We ate lots of junk food, laughed hard and played "Catch Phrase." We lost some sleep, but these guys were so worth it. We had great conversations about how they see God, tried to answer some tough questions and challenged them to become world changers!

**MENTORSHIP** - In our last prayer letter, I mentioned that a local judge would be assigning juvenile students to me for one-on-one Bible discipleship. There are two guys in particular that could sure use your prayers. (I'll just use initials as to keep their privacy).

The first student I'll call J. M. He is struggling with understanding who Jesus really is and wondering why his dad is having to live with an incurable disease, which is also genetic J. M. is only 12 and this sure seems like a lot for him to think about at this time in his life.

The second student I'll call B. T. His dad was killed in the Murrah Bombing in 1995 and he has struggled ever since. He eventually dropped out of school and found trouble. Both of these guys are dealing with massive amounts of anger and confusion. Pray God would clear their minds, heal their hearts and draw them to Him.

**WESTERN OAKS 8th GRADERS** - God is at work! The boys I work with are involved in basketball at school, so at every opportunity I attend their games. None of them have a dad at home and at times it's all too obvious. I have been meeting every week with these guys for pizza and Bible study. The attendance ranges from 4 to 15. The faculty at their school told me these were the toughest students to deal with, so they were glad to see someone working with them. Pizza (and Scripture) does wonders for hungry guys. Some of them were baptized in our church in January! These guys have awesome potential to be great leaders. God is doing a work... please continue to pray for these guys as they are just beginning to get to know God and understand Him.

As you can tell, God is moving and at work in the lives of people everywhere! What a privilege we have to be involved in such a small part. You are a continual source of joy and encouragement to us as you pray and give so faithfully! We love you. Sam and Trish
