Romans 13:10

Overcoming Evil with Good:

Key Principle 13:1-7 = Respect All Authority.
Key Principle 13:8-10 = Love All Mankind.

Rom 13:8 = The Christian Life.

13:8 C.T. = Keep on owing nothing to anyone except to love one another of the same kind; for the one loving a different kind has filled up law.

Step 1: See love for all as a debt.

Rom 13:9 = The Bottom Line.

13:9 C.T. = For this, "You shall not commit adultery, you shall not murder, you shall not steal, you shall not covet," and if there is any other commandment, it is summed up in this saying, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."
