13:12 C.T. = The night is increasing, and the day is near. Therefore, may we lay aside the works of the darkness and put on the armor of the light.

Step #2: Decisions for important changes need to be made.

Rom 13:13 = Time to Lay Aside Encumbrances.

13:13 C.T. = May we walk in a good form as in the day, not in partying and drunkenness, not in sexual promiscuity and lasciviousness, not in debates and jealousy.
