How to Build Relationships

Dear Ones,

While I am preparing for a ministry trip to Colombia (Dec 7-23) Pastor Ramon is busy organizing several conferences.

Lord willing I will share the Word and distribute study Bibles and theology books that we recently shipped, to approximately 200 pastors/leaders from many churches in several cities. We also plan to meet with pastors in Peru and Brazil (we have materials in Portuguese as well).

Other prayer points are:

- * I will teach in the church's Bible Institute in Bogota where they meet several times a week and enrollment has grown from about 45 to 125 in six months.
- * We are going to investigate the possibility of a church plant / Bible Institute in Villa where there are seven families requesting help and oversight to launch a new work in 2008.
- * We hope to meet with pastors in the Medina region who have endured persecution in order to encourage them, supply Bibles and study tools while considering how we can assist them more effectively in their ministry there.
- * Wisdom as we gather information on the possibility of using radio in the capitol city as an outreach tool.
- * Prayer for provision for my travel (airfare) to Colombia, Pastor Ramon's and my travel needs within Colombia as we do conferences in 3-4 cities. Also help to mail Bibles and books to several key areas within the country.

A Note of Praise & Thanksgiving: We just received news that Pastor Ramon's church is moving to a new location. This larger building will help accommodate the rapid growth and will seat many more.

More Bibles! In the next day or two we will send you info as I am excited about the possibility of purchasing more study Bibles in Spanish at a discount of 80%. We just learned that the publisher is now liquidating all their *wide margined* Bibles and has offered this special price until they are sold out.
